INSTRUCTIONS

SECTION 1

- A) This section refers to your personal details. (Full Name, Address, Date of Birth and Telephone No.)
- B) This section requests information about matters which may be relevant to a decision to approve an application. You must include any incidents of criminal or related history. Details must also be provided regarding any employment as a Police Officer. (Offences for which an application will be refused are set out in Section 2).
- C) The form should then be signed and dated by both you and a witness. A witness must be any person over the age of eighteen years.
- D) You must **attach** copies of documents that prove your identity.
Acceptable documents are:-
i) Photographic driver's licence
ii) Firearms licence or Security Industry licence
iii) Other documents such as a passport/visa, birth certificate etc.
- E) This form and relevant documentation will be sent to the Security Industry Registry, by your Registered Training Organisation.
- F) The last section will be completed by the Security Industry Registry once a criminal history check has been completed. Notification will be returned verifying your suitability or otherwise to undertake training.

SECTION 2

Set out below are mandatory grounds for refusal of a Security Licence. Approval would not be given to undertake security training if the person:-

- has, within the period of 10 years before the application for the licence was made, been convicted in New South Wales or elsewhere of an offence prescribed by the regulations, whether or not the offence is an offence under New South Wales law, or
- has, within the period of 5 years before the application for the licence was made, been found guilty (but with no conviction recorded) by a court in New South Wales or elsewhere of an offence prescribed by the regulations, whether or not the offence is an offence under New South Wales law, or
- has, within the period of 10 years before the application for the licence was made, been removed or dismissed from the Police Service of New South Wales or from the Police Force of any other jurisdiction (whether in Australia or overseas).

Prescribed offences for which an applicant MUST be disqualified are:

- Offences relating to the possession or use of a firearm or a weapon.
- Offences relating to prohibited drugs as defined in the Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985.
- Serious offences involving assault.
- Offences involving fraud, dishonesty or stealing.
- Offences involving robbery.
